Directions

Getting Here by Road

By car:

Leave the M1 motorway at Junction 25 and join the A52 to Nottingham. Go straight on at the first and second islands. On reaching the third island with the Toby Inn on the left hand side and a petrol station on the right, turn right onto Woodside Road (the B6464).

Follow Woodside Road for approximately ½ a mile to another smaller island. Turn left at the island into the West Entrance to the University of Nottingham and follow the road around to the left for approximately ½ a mile, the entrance to the EMCC car park is situated on the right.

From the A1 at Grantham, take the A52 to Nottingham. Travel for approximately 30 miles, passed Bingham, Radcliffe on Trent and West Bridgford.

On approaching Nottingham, pass the Industrial Park with the Showcase Cinema Complex on your left and take the left hand slip lane down to an island. Turn left at the island onto Beeston Road. Follow the road onto the dual carriageway, University Boulevard. At the island turn right and the next island turn right again into the West Entrance to the University of Nottingham. Follow the road around to the left for approximately ½ a mile, the entrance to the EMCC car park is situated on the right.

Parking

There is a free car park with 220 spaces next to the conference centre. Once the EMCC car park is full, there are parking bays along Beeston Lane, right opposite the entrance to the EMCC; please note we are expecting in excess of 250 delegates and cannot guarantee parking for all attendees – parking will be strictly on a first-come-first-serve basis.

Getting Here by Train

Nottingham train station is the nearest major railway station for the University. It is in the City Centre, about 3 - 4 miles from the University.

Directions from the train station to the Campus

Turn left out of the short stay car park

Turn left at the traffic lights

Turn left at the large roundabout (you will see the BBC building)

Carry straight on Castle Boulevard for approximately 2 miles

You will pass Castle Marina on your left and at the next small roundabout (Grove pub) turn left onto Abby Bridge

Carry straight on (past the Queens Medical Centre) until you reach the large roundabout and go straight over (2nd exit) onto Beeston Road

Beeston Road leads onto University Boulevard A6005

Go straight over the first small roundabout

Get into the right hand lane and turn right at the second roundabout which will bring you onto the University Campus (Beeston Lane)

Follow the road round until you come to the EMCC situated on the right hand side

Beeston Railway Station is closer to the University, just 1-2 miles from the Beeston entrance of the campus. From the station you can get a [taxi](#) to the University, or catch one of the buses listed above under "Beeston". There are also frequent trains between Nottingham and Beeston, journey times taking around 4 minutes.

By Bus:

From Broadmarsh bus station (about 250 metres walk from the railway station), catch one of the following Trent and Barton buses:

University Boulevard: Rainbow 5
East, South and West Entrances: 18, 32

The Nottingham City Transport Unilink service (34) also runs from the Broadmarsh Centre via Angel Row, Derby Road and QMC and stops at various points on the campus.

Other Nottingham City Transport services also pass near or through the campus and can be picked up from stops near the Market Square in the City Centre. The location in brackets pin points where they stop near the University.

From Beeston (approximately 1.5 miles)

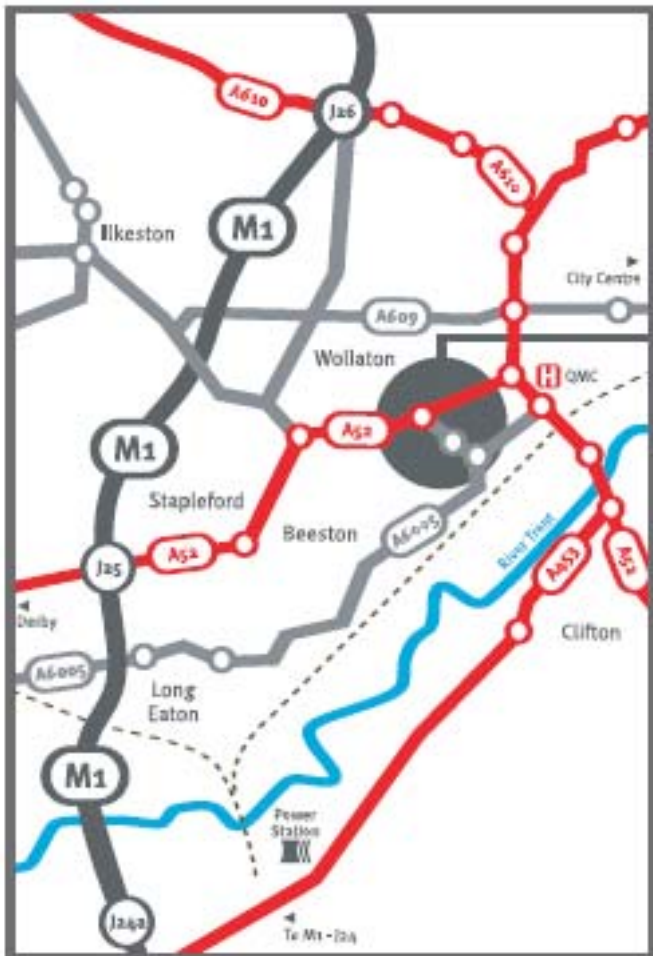
The Rainbow 5 Trent Barton service runs from Beeston Bus Station (about 10 minutes walk from the railway station along Station Road) past the South and North entrances to the University, as well as passing QMC. Nottingham City Transport service 13 has a stop in Queen's Road, about 5 minutes walk from the Beeston railway station, turning right out of Station Road.

- 1 Leave the M1 at Junction 25 (Nottingham, Derby, A52).
- 2 Join the A52 towards Nottingham.
- 3 Remain on the A52 for 4.4 miles until the roundabout junction with A6464.
- 4 Turn right (third exit) at the roundabout onto Woodside Road (A6464).
- 5 At the next roundabout turn left (first exit) into University Park Campus West Entrance (Beeston Lane).
- 6 The EMCC is on the right hand side.

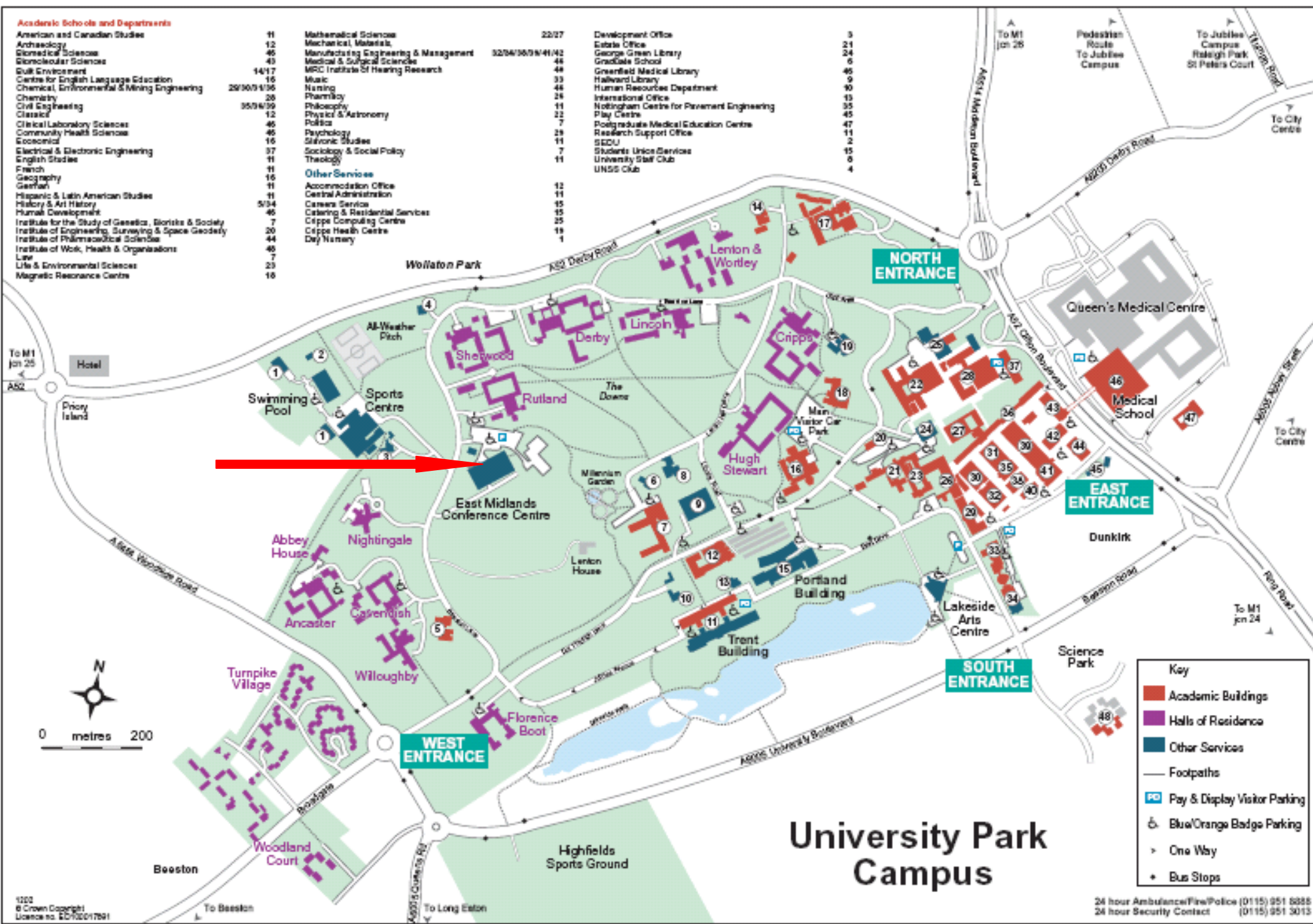
